HIGHER & DEGREE APPRENTICESHIP

Apprenticeships offer a valid alternative to university, with the qualification to match.

Completing an apprenticeship is a way to earn and learn, gaining a qualification, long term career path and the possibility for higher earnings, with the plus side of no university debts and no tuition fees. As an apprentice you will be employed by a company, you will have a contract of employment, get paid a salary (at the least the minimum wage for apprentices £4.81 aged under 19 or those in their first year) but many companies pay more than this particularly for higher apprenticeships. You will spend most of the week at work (usually a minimum of 30 hours) obtaining valuable workplace skills and you'll also spend time attending college, a university or a training provider to study your qualification.

HIGHER & DEGREE APPRENTICESHIPS

Higher or Degree Apprenticeships are available at levels 4-7 and they combine work with study. Typically, higher apprentices study part time at college, university or with a training provider. Apprenticeships take between one and five years to complete.
