WHAT ARE MY CHOICES?

All young people are required to participate in education until the end of the academic year they turn 18. Young people must engage in one of the following:

- An Apprenticeship
- T-levels
- Study Programme
- Full time work involving at least 280 hours of education
- Full time education including A Levels
- Home education



Apprenticeships offer the chance to learn and gain nationally recognised qualifications whilst earning a salary.

As an apprentice you will be working in a real job where you will be employed by a company, have a contract of employment, get paid a salary whilst obtaining valuable workplace skills and experience.

INTERMEDIATE APPRENTICESHIP

- Level 2
- 12 - 18 months
- Equivalent to 5 GCSEs 4 - 9

ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIP

- Level 3
- 18 - 48 months
- Equivalent to 2 A-levels

HIGHER & DEGREE APPRENTICESHIP

- Levels 4, 5, 6, 7
- 24 months+
- Equivalent to foundation degree level+

WHERE DO APPRENTICESHIPS LEAD?

Your current skills and qualifications will form the starting point for your Apprenticeship journey. Learners starting on an Apprenticeship level 2 can progress onto a level 3 Apprenticeship.

Some learners, depending on qualifications will commence the programme at level 3 and then they can progress onto a Higher Apprenticeship. There are plenty of options on completing an Apprenticeship programme to enter skilled employment and further training or to progress onto a Higher Apprenticeship either part time or full time. HIGHER & DEGREE APPRENTICESHIPS

Higher or Degree Apprenticeships are available at levels 4-7 and they combine work with study. Typically, higher apprentices study part time at college, university or with a training provider. Apprenticeships take between one and five years to complete.

- A level 4 or 5 is equivalent to a Higher Education Certificate/Diploma or a foundation degree
- A level 6 is equivalent to a Bachelor's degree
- A level 7 is equivalent to a Master's degree

HOW TO APPLY FOR AN APPRENTICESHIP



Find the apprenticeship that's right for you – visit www.findapprenticeship.service.gov.uk

- Click on create an account (top right corner) and register your details
- Don't forget to set up alerts to get notifications of apprenticeships that may interest you


Once you have created an account you are then able to start applying for an apprenticeship.

- Make sure you 'sell yourself' on your application form/s

HIGHER TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS (HTQs)



HTQs are an alternative to apprenticeships or degrees.

They may suit you if you want a more practical, employer-led study programme.

HTQs are for students over 18 who want to study a subject to prepare them for skilled jobs. You can study HTQs full time or part time. They are usually taught at colleges, universities or independent training providers.

Approved HTQs are new and existing level 4 and 5 qualifications approved by the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education.

There are many different types of HTQs, such as:

- higher national diplomas
- higher national certificates
- foundation degrees
- higher education diplomas

Alternatively, you can ask your local college or training provider.

STUDY PROGRAMME

The Study Programme assists 16-19 year olds to gain qualifications and employability skills to progress into further education, an apprenticeship or employment.

It offers a flexible programme which may include a mix of qualifications, including English and maths for young people who have not achieved GCSE 4 - 9, and work experience. Study programmes may be undertaken at a further education college, sixth form college or with a training provider.

T-LEVELS

THE NEXT LEVEL QUALIFICATION

T Levels are an alternative to A levels, apprenticeships and other 16 to 19 courses. Equivalent to 3 A levels, a T Level focuses on vocational skills and can help students into skilled employment, higher study or apprenticeships.

T Level students spend 80% of the course in the classroom, learning the skills that employers need. The other 20% is a meaningful industry placement, where you will put these skills into action. One T Level takes 2 years of full-time study and is equivalent to 3 A levels and is a nationally-recognised qualification.

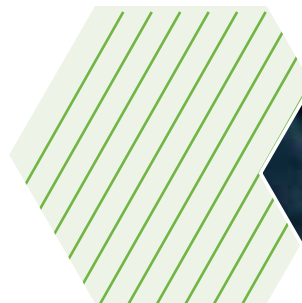
